Infusion therapy is a way to deliver medication or fluids through a thin catheter or needle, usually through an intravenous (IV) method.

Infusion center services include blood transfusions, IV antibiotics, chemotherapy and other types of IV treatment. Benefits include:

- Registered nurses are specially trained in infusion therapy, and many have advanced certifications in IV therapy and cancer care.
- Private rooms include televisions, sound systems and recliners to help you stay comfortable during your treatment.

During infusion or IV therapy, electronic computerized pumps control the rate of the infusion so that you safely receive the right amount of medicine or fluids over the right amount of time.
