

As part of our SurviveWell Program, a registered dietitian is available to discuss specific questions and concerns with patients at Northwestern Medicine Lake Forest Hospital Cancer Center and Northwestern Medicine Cancer Center Grayslake.

At these consultations, patients may receive:

Screenings and assessment to establish nutrition goals and identify risks

Education about minimizing and coping with treatment side effects that may lead to weight loss, dehydration and an overall decrease in energy

Practical suggestions to help meet individual nutritional needs

Suggestions for family or caretakers to help patients maximize nutrition intake and quality of life

Follow-up care as needed throughout treatment
