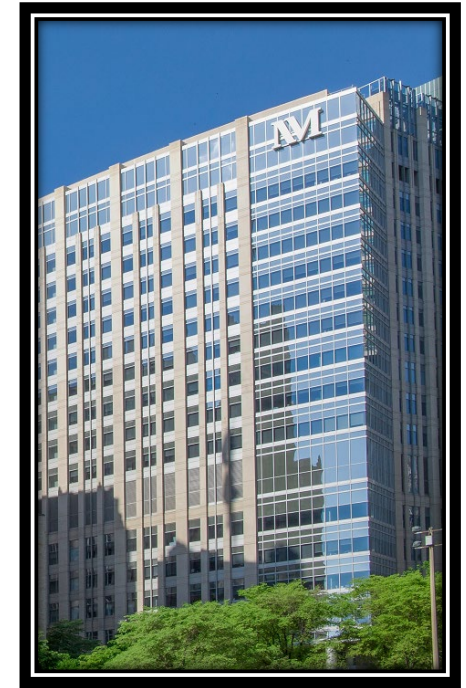
The purpose of this activity is to enhance the knowledge base of renal disease professionals as it pertains to kidney transplantation and their patient population and to complete the following objectives:
