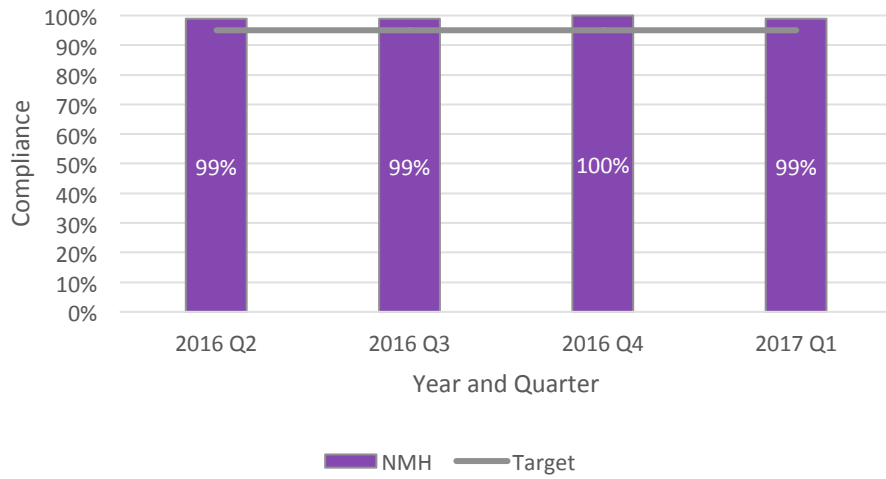

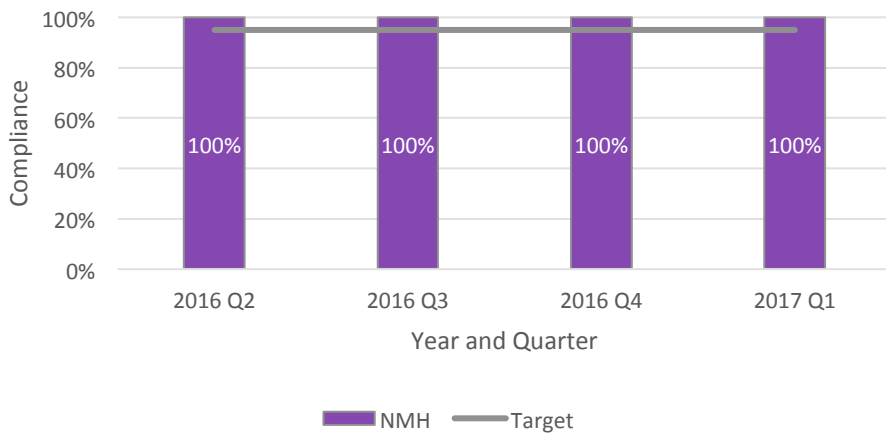
Set Measure	Name	Details
STK 1	Venous Thromboembolism	Prevention of Blood Clots
STK 2	Discharged on Antithrombotic Therapy	Medication Given at Discharge to prevent Recurrence of Stroke
STK 3	Anticoagulation Therapy for Atrial Fibrillation/Flutter	Stroke Patients with Atrial Fibrillation Prescribed Medication at Discharge
STK 4	Thrombolytic Therapy	Stroke Treatment Started in a Timely Manner
STK 5	Antithrombotic Therapy By End of Hospital Day Two	Medication to Prevent Blood Clots for Stroke Patients Timely
STK 6	Discharged on Statin Medication	Cholesterol Reducing Medication Prescribed to Stroke Patients at Discharge
STK8	Stroke Education	Education for Stroke Patients and Families Provided
STK 10	Assessed for Rehabilitation	Evaluation of Stroke Patients for Rehabilitation Care

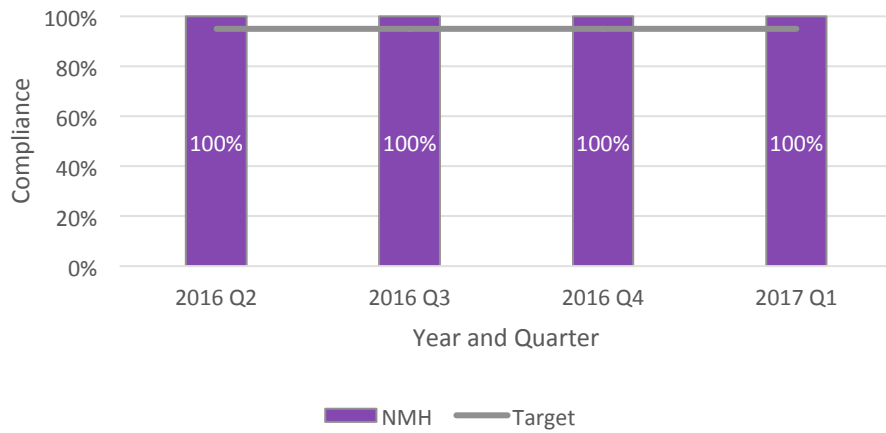
STK-1: Prevention of Blood Clots



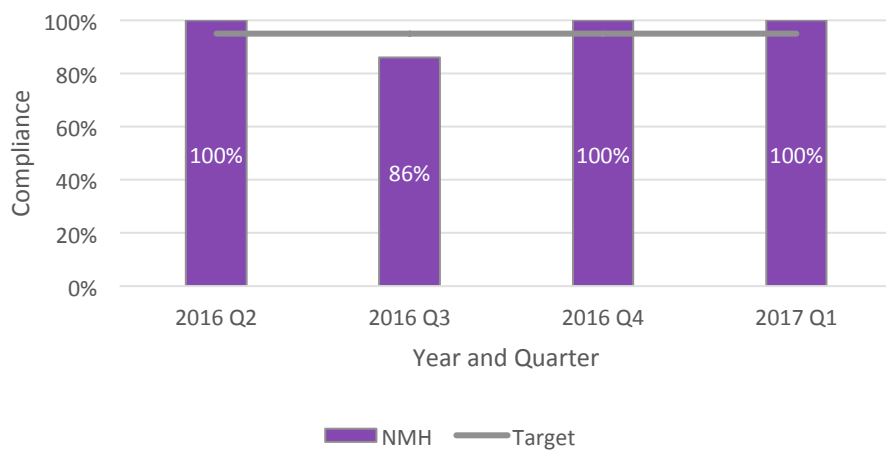
STK-2: Medication Given at Discharge to prevent Recurrence of Stroke



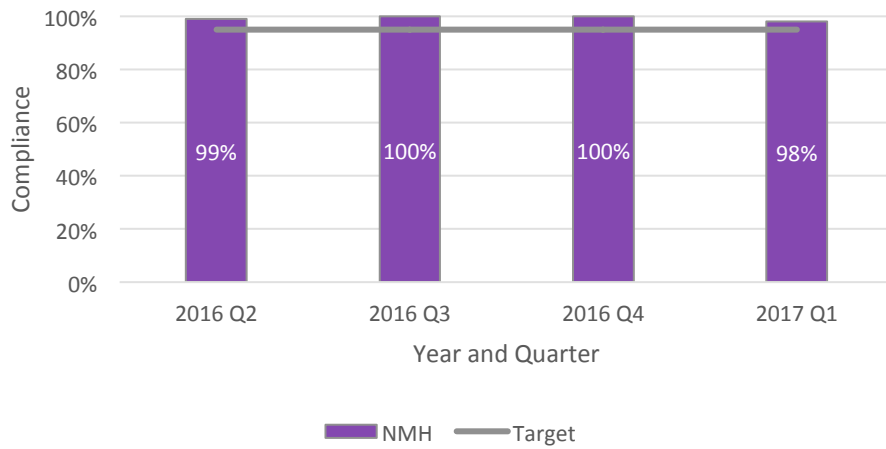
STK-3: Stroke Patients with Atrial Fibrillation Prescribed Medication at Discharge



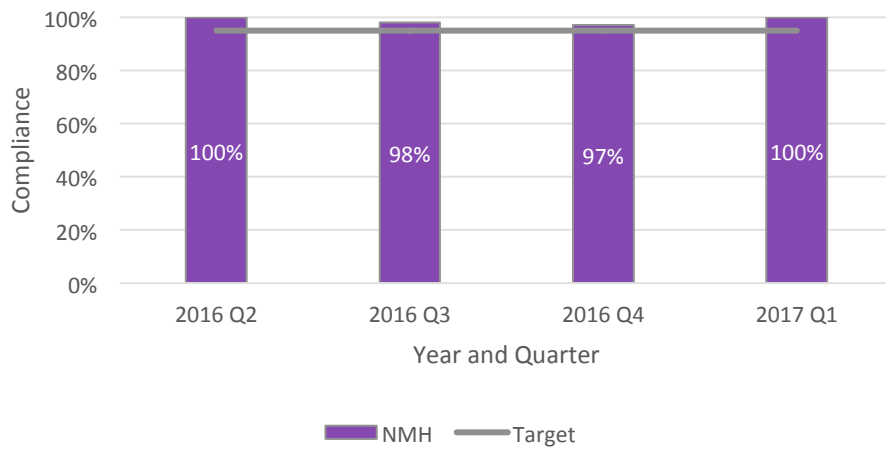
STK-4: Stroke Treatment Started in a Timely Manner



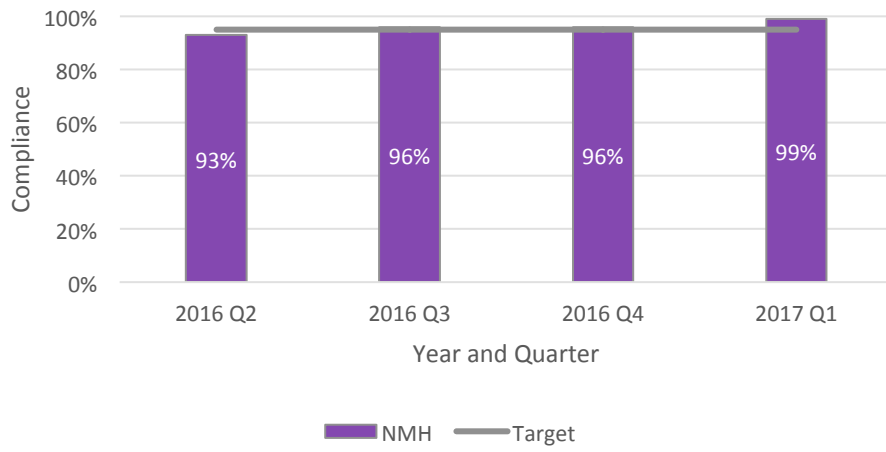
STK-5: Medication to Prevent Blood Clots for Stroke Patients Timely
