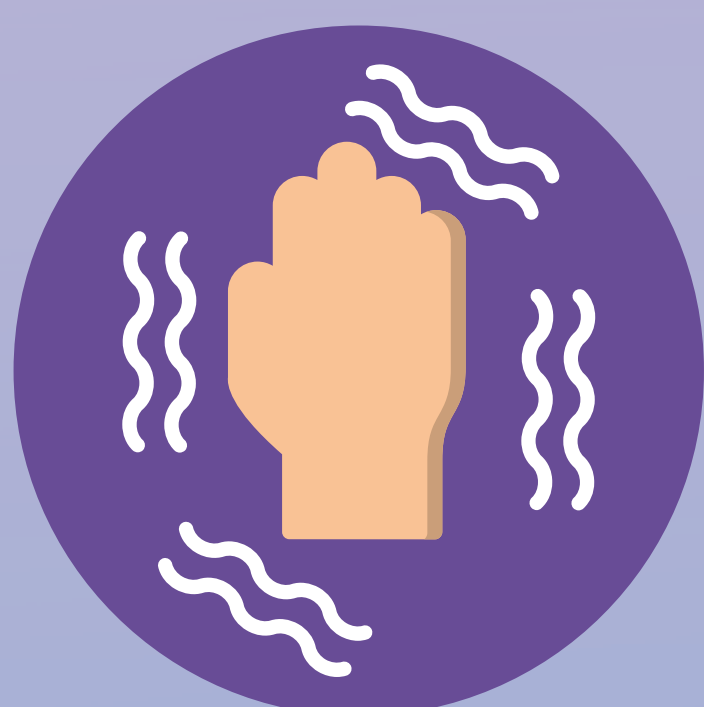

WHAT YOU CAN SEE

Tremors

Mask-like facial expression

Small, cramped handwriting

Difficulty with fine motor movement

Shuffling or taking smaller steps

Dizziness

Memory loss

Vision changes

Hallucinations

Anxiety

Bladder problems

WHAT YOU HAVE TO LOOK CLOSER TO SEE

Change in balance

Weakness in voice

Stooping of posture

Slowed movement

WHAT YOU CAN'T SEE

Stiffness and muscle rigidity

Constipation

Depression

Pain

Change in sleep patterns

Loss of sense of smell
