

Digestive Health Center OSMOPREP® BOWEL PREPARATION

TIMELINE OF YOUR COLONOSCOPY PREPARATION

When you go to the pharmacy to pick up your bowel preparation, please also pick up simethicone anti-gas tablets (Gas-X or any generic brand) which are available over-the-counter without a prescription. While this medicine isn't required, taking it as detailed below will improve the quality of your bowel preparation.

Note: You should not take this medication if you have chronic kidney disease or failure.

The Day Before Your Procedure	
5:00 pm	Dose 1: 4 tablets and 8 oz. of water
5:15 pm	Dose 2: 4 tablets and 8 oz. or water
5:30 pm	Dose 3: 4 tablets and 8 oz. or water
5:45 pm	Dose 4: 4 tablets and 8 oz. or water
6:00 pm	Dose 5: 4 tablets and 8 oz. or water Chew two tablets of simethicone 125mg chewable tablets. This can be purchased overthe-counter. This step is preferred, but not essential.
	The Day of Your Procedure
5 hours Prior to Arrival	 Dose 6: 4 tablets and 8 oz. of water Dose 7: (15 minutes later) 4 tablets and 8 oz. of water Dose 8: (15 minutes later) 4 tablets and 8 oz. of water Chew two tablets of simethicone 125mg chewable tablets. This can be purchased overthe-counter. This step is preferred, but not essential.

PREPARATION TIPS

- 1. You must drink the recommended amount of water this is VERY IMPORTANT.
- 2. Since the bowel preparation will cause diarrhea, it is important to stay hydrated. Make a conscious effort to drink clear liquids throughout the day to prevent dehydration.
- 3. Be sure to finish the entire prep or else the colon may not clean adequately which may result in you needing to repeat your colonoscopy within 6-12 months.
- 4. Your output/bowel movements should be clear (or yellow) after you've completed the bowel preparation. If you are still seeing solid stool/brown stool after completing the 2nd dose, please call our office 312-695-5620.
