	Narcs and Reformation	The team is working on improving screening and interventions for opioid dependent patients in the Grayslake Emergency Room. The team has already increased the percentage of ED providers with Data 2000 Certification (to be able to prescribe suboxone to patients with opioid use disorder) from 0% to 8.3%. They are continuing to work on an educational series and Epic build for Narcan to continue to see results.
 <i>In progress</i>	Now you CIWA, now you don't	The team is working on improving the detection and monitoring of alcohol withdrawal syndrome at NLFH. The team identified that the current process and tools lead to delayed recognition and management of at-risk patients and over-monitoring in those misidentified. They are working to utilize PAWSS as the screening tool and switching from CIWA to mMinds as a validate tool for beside monitoring. The team is awaiting final Epic changes in order to determine results.
	OPIE: Opioid Prescriber Individualization and Evaluation	The team successfully decreased the amount of morphine equivalents prescribed on discharge after a C-Section at NLFH by 33%. This was accomplished through patient and provider education and scheduled non-opioid pain medication to individualize pain medication and decrease opioid over prescribing.
